 value from our by-products
- To analyse and interpret scientific data available from internal and external sources to identify patterns or trends that encourage opportunities for innovation
- To assess internal and external opportunities, projects and partnerships and provide recommendations to the business to support our Business Plan and Framework objectives
- To produce technical reports, briefing papers and business cases and to carry out critical review of reports produced by others
- To mobilise, manage and lead projects, as assigned, through project and programme management, reporting and risk management
- To apply best practice Project Management principles, tools and techniques such as Lifecycle Management, Stage Reviews and writing Business Cases

- Undertake on-site sampling, monitoring and supervision at relevant sites, such as mine water treatment and ochre processing facilities/customer sites
- Stakeholder engagement, including internal and external partners
- To champion projects assigned to you and communicate regarding them at all levels
- To produce regular Highlight Reports and ad hoc management status reports
- To innovate and improve project management methods
- To seek to deliver or exceed the aims of innovation projects, identifying opportunities and delivering additional benefits where possible
- Ensuring the embedding of innovation within the Authority and supply chain including the successful adoption of innovation projects into business as usual
- To identify and promote commercial opportunities as part of the innovation process or from opportunities with external parties
- To protect the intellectual property of the Authority and any third parties protected under agreements
